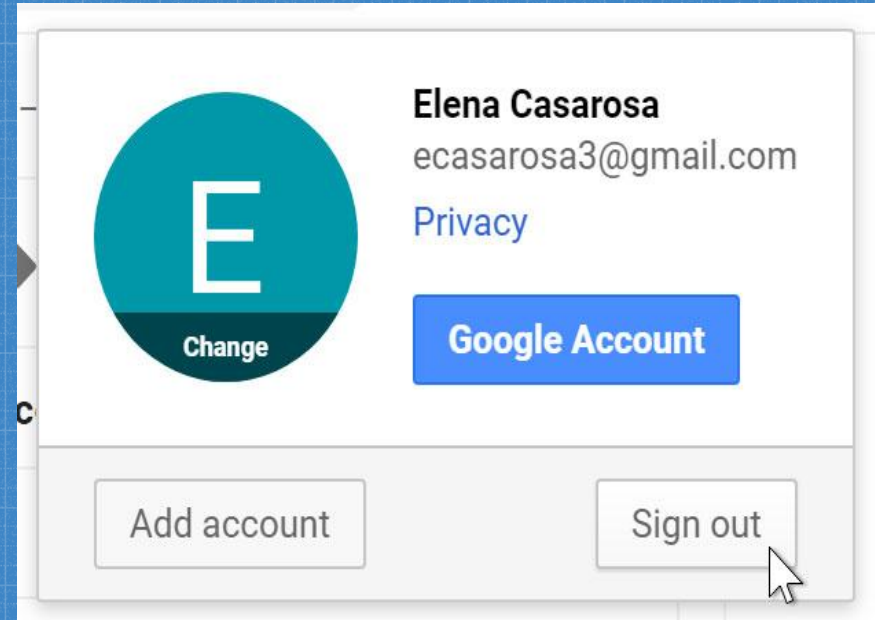

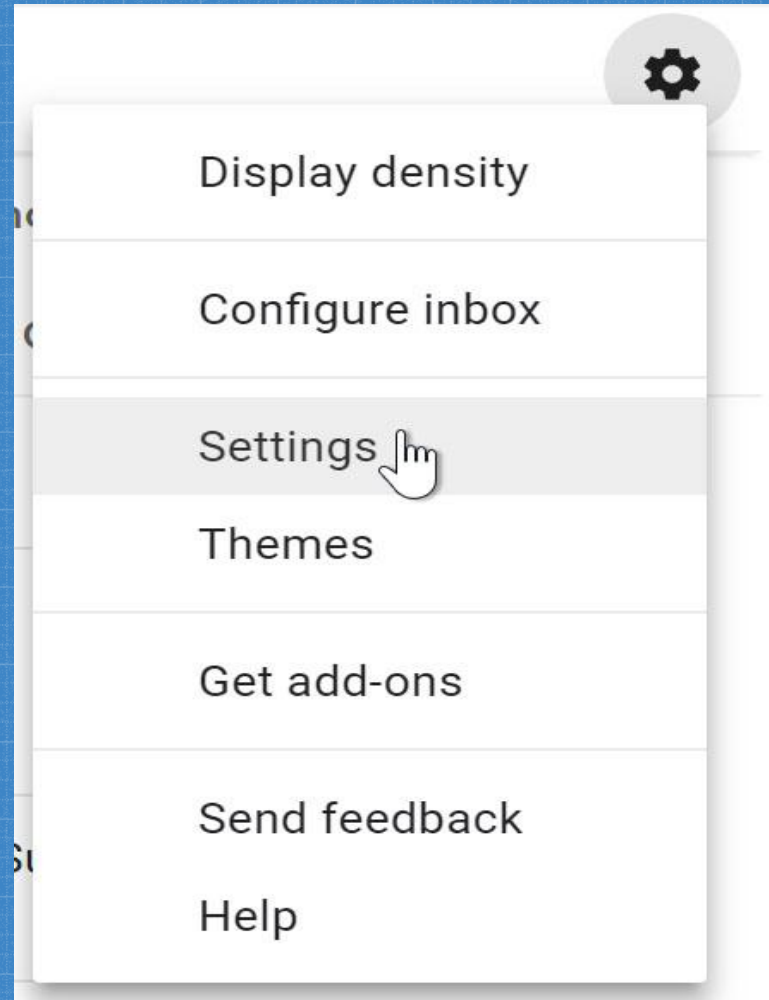
1. In the top-right corner of the page, locate the circle that has your first initial.

2. Click the circle and select Sign out.




To access your mail settings:
